NASTAR



NASTAR stands for NAtional STAndard Race and is the largest public grassroots ski racing program in the world. Founded in 1968 by SKI Magazine, NASTAR boasts more than 100,000 races at over 100 resorts around the country and gives recreational racers an opportunity to compete and compare their scores to friends and family. Racers are scored by earning a handicap that represents their ability. The handicap provides participants with a tangible number (handicap) that is the percentage they are behind the time of the National Standard or the National Pacesetter.

- Saturday's and Sunday's from 12:30 3:00 PM
- No additional cost to HVST athlete's and parents
- Liability waiver required and pass assigned
- Great opportunity to refine racing skills and gain confidence
- Coaches are often around for feedback and even run gates
- Open to the public, family & friends for a fee
- NASTAR National Championships Early April, 2024
 - To qualify for the NASTAR National Championships participants must win a medal on one or more race days.
 - Participants can qualify throughout the season with the last day of qualification on March 31st.

NASTAR is open to the public for a fee, friends and family at a small fee.

You DO NOT need to be a skilled skier to participate!

Vail




- Vail Resorts dictates policy and procedures at Hidden Valley HVST must comply

 - HVST athletes cannot store / leave items in the lodge

Required Equipment



No athlete will be allowed to participate unless they have the basic required equipment

REQUIRED FOR ALL HVST ATHLETES

- Racing helmet (NO SOFT EAR HELMETS!)
- Ski clothing
 - HVST Team Coat
 - Ski pants, ski socks and proper underlayers
 - Ski gloves/mittens
- Goggles w/day and night lenses (clear/light/non-mirror for night training)
- Ski/snowboard boots that are properly fitted
- Ski poles that are the proper length
- Ski straps, 2-pair for each set of skis
- Proper length and tuned skis (more details follow) No rental skis permitted
- Label your athlete's gear
- Where to purchase equipment: HVST Facebook Page, The Alpine Shop, ski.com, etc.

NO SOFT EAR HELMETS

Required Equipment



DEV 1

- Race Skis Junior or Adult
 - Multi-event or SL required for all training and NASTAR
- Hard-eared helmet
- Ski poles with straps or glove clips

DEV 2

- Race Skis Junior or Adult
 - Multi-event or SL required for all training and NASTAR
 - GS also recommended for U14 and older.
- Hard-eared helmet
- Race ski poles with straps or glove clips

RACE

- Race Skis Junior or Adult
 - U12 and under SL required, GS optional
 - U14 and older Both GS and SL required
- Hard-eared helmet
- Race ski poles GS and SL with hand guards



Race skis not recommended for use in the Terrain Park

Optional Equipment



Equipment – Optional

- Helmet SL Face Guard or separate SL helmet with face guard
- SL hand guards / Shin guards (SL) / Forearm guards (GS)
- Mouth Guard
- Race Suit
- All-mountain skis recommended for recreational skiing
- Cut resistant under layers
- Neck gator or face mask
- Boot bag (heated boot bag)
- Ski/board bag
- Boot dryers
- Microfiber lens cleaning cloth
- Ski/Board tuning equipment
- Waterproofing balm for leather gloves
- Hand/foot warmers
- Rain poncho
- Equipment TUNING is highly recommended
 - Captain can advise and manage tuning @ Hidden Valley

- We will have coats for pick-up at the team event / fundraiser and at the first practice or before
- For those going to camps, please make sure to get a coat prior
- You own your athletes coat and can then sell it or trade it when your athlete outgrows
- We will take new orders every March, so if you will need a new size, please inform us by Feb. 1, 2024
- Coats are purchased at a discount that is carried over to the family

Team Captain

- The HVST board created a new role of Team Captain, which allows an eligible athlete to hold a leadership position that will focus on our team development, athletes and coaches support and coaching of younger athletes.
- WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY? All Race Team athletes who hold a GPA over 3.2/4.0 and who are in 10-12 grade.
- DUE DATE: September 1, 2023

Code of Conduct



- •SPORTSMANSHIP treat teammates, coaches, resort employees, general public, competition officials, facilities and opponents with respect & display good sportsmanship at all times
- •SAFETY follow all safety guidelines & report any safety concerns
- •DISCIPLINE AND COMMITMENT attend all practices and events unless there is a valid reason for absence, arrive always on-time and prepared
- •TEAMWORK Foster a positive team environment by supporting, encouraging and including teammates
- •INTEGRITY Compete fairly and within the rules of the sport & uphold the reputation of the team, both on and off the slopes
- •CONDUCT Be mindful of language and behavior, refraining from using offensive or derogatory remarks
- •COMMUNICATION Maintain open and respectful communication with coaches, teammates, and parents. Express concerns or issues in a constructive manner, seeking resolution through proper channels.
- •PERSONAL CONDUCT Be a positive role model for the team and the skiing community & avoid engaging in activities that may impair physical or mental performance. Use of illegal substances such as VAPING, SMOKING, DRINKING ALCOHOL is STRICTLY PROHIBITED. Failure to comply might result is losing the spot on the team.
- •COMPLIANCE Adhere to all applicable laws, regulations, and policies related to skiing and team participation.

By adhering to this code of conduct, all members of the ski team can contribute to a positive and supportive environment that fosters growth, teamwork, and success.
